

Louisa County Agricultural Fair

Judged Exhibits Rules and Regulations

1. Entries may be made on the official entry blank in the catalog, a photocopy of the form, online at www.louisacountyagfair.com, or ruled paper. Entry forms must include complete name, class, and name of each entry.
2. Pre-registration of exhibit entries, either online or by mail, is suggested to facilitate the tagging process. Mail entry forms to Louisa County Ag Fair, c/o Melinda McCall, P.O. Box 492, Louisa, VA 23093 no later than July 20, 2011.
3. Judged entries may be brought to the fairgrounds on Wednesday, July 27th between 5-8 p.m., or Thursday, July 28th between 7:30-10 a.m. We are unable to accept any item after 10 a.m. because the judging will take place shortly after this time. Baked goods should be brought to the fairgrounds Thursday morning for judging that day.
4. Exhibits may be removed no earlier than 6 p.m. on Saturday, July 30th. During these hours only, ticket stubs may be used to enter the fairgrounds for the purpose of collecting your exhibits. The Judged Exhibits building will close at 6 p.m. on Saturday July 30th, but remaining entries may be picked up on Sunday afternoon from 2-3 p.m. or Monday evening from 6-7 p.m. Those exhibits not claimed by Monday evening will be considered abandoned and the fair will not be responsible for them. Where possible, ribbons and entry tags will be brought to the extension office.
5. Exhibitors are responsible for placing entries in the proper class. Judges will not consider entries placed in the wrong class.
6. No exhibitor will be allowed to exhibit more than one article in one class.
7. Classes with only one entry will be awarded ribbons at the discretion of the judge.
8. Ribbons will be awarded for first, second, and third places. Best of show ribbons will be awarded for each department and for each separate age group.
9. Articles exhibited must be the work of the exhibitor and/or grown by the exhibitor and be amateur only. All items must have been made or grown within the past 12 calendar months and not previously entered in the Louisa County Ag Fair.
10. All Exhibitors must be residents of, employed by, or active participants in the county of Louisa.

11. All judges decisions are final
