

2016 JUDGED EXHIBITS RULES & REGULATIONS
Louisa County Agricultural Fair

All exhibitors must be residents of, employed by, or active participants in the County of Louisa.

Articles exhibited must be the work of the exhibitor and/or grown by the exhibitor and be amateur only. All items must have been made or grown within the past 12 calendar months and not previously entered in the Louisa County Agricultural Fair.

Exhibitors are responsible for placing entries in the proper class. Judges will not consider entries placed in the wrong class.

An exhibitor may enter only one article in a class.

An exhibitor may place an entry "FOR DISPLAY ONLY" if desired (this should be indicated on the entry tag); this entry will not be judged.

No cross-entering is permitted: Youth (18 and under) may not enter adult competitions and adults may not enter youth competitions.

Classes with only one entry will be awarded ribbons at the discretion of the judge.

Ribbons are awarded for first, second, and third places. Best of show ribbons are awarded for each department and for each separate age group. Only one Best of Show award is selected for each department, except the Youth Division where one Best of Show is selected for the A, B, and C age groups.

All judges' decisions are final.

Exhibits may be removed no earlier than 7 PM on Saturday, July 30. Ticket stubs may be used to enter the fairgrounds for the purpose of collecting your exhibits. The Judged Exhibits building will close at 9 PM on Saturday, July 30. Remaining entries may be picked up from 2-3 PM on Sunday, July 31.

All items not claimed by Sunday afternoon will be considered abandoned and taken to the Extension Office in the county office building.

The exhibitor assumes all risks of damage or loss either to person or property for any cause. It is further expressly understood and agreed by the exhibitor that the Louisa County Agricultural Fair Association and the Louisa County Fire Department that the said "fair" incurs no liability or obligation to the exhibitor other than to permit the exhibitor to use the grounds for exhibit.
